<p><b>Please be at school no later than 9:00 am. for registration. We will be loading the buses at 9:45 am. This is not a sleepover event. All participants must ride to and return from Disney in PTSA buses. No Uber, Lyft, or taxi is allowed to take a student home from Disney.</b></p> <p><b>Departure from Grand Arts PTSA is 10:00 am.</b></p> <p>Participant backpack is subject to a search prior to leaving, and at any time. You give consent that the participant may be subject of a pat down search by Disney while on the premises of the Disneyland Resort. You will need your <b>ID and receipt</b> to get on the bus.</p>		
<p>Participant acknowledges that face coverings are optional but recommended in all indoor locations. Face coverings are required, regardless of vaccination status, in certain indoor health settings, such as in First Aid.</p>		
<p>Participant is responsible for own food while at the event. NO glass containers, outside food or liquids are permitted.</p>		
<p>Alcoholic beverages, smoking marijuana including marijuana enriched products, or any illegal substances are prohibited at the Disneyland Resort. Tobacco products including electronic cigarettes and vaping products are prohibited.</p>		
<p>Participant will adhere to dress code per Disney rules.</p>		
<p>Participant will behave in a manner that is deemed normal by civilized society. Weapons or objects that appear to be weapons are not allowed. Laser pointers or other items deemed potentially harmful or disruptive are prohibited.</p>		
<p>Participant must remain on Disney property at all times. Wristband must be worn at all times. If participant loses wristband, it will not be replaced, and participant will be sent home, with parent/guardian/authorized person picking up participant from the park. If participant leaves the Disney property at any time, participant will be automatically expelled and parent/guardian must immediately pick up participant from park.</p>
